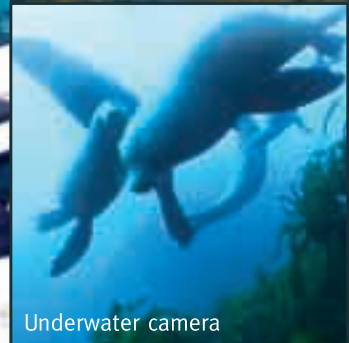

Seal feeding frenzy

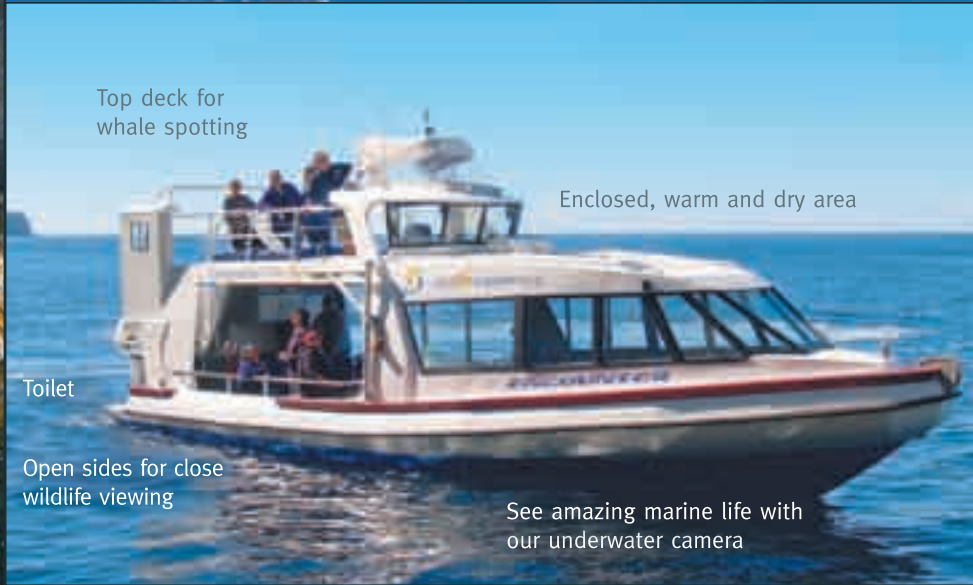


Underwater camera

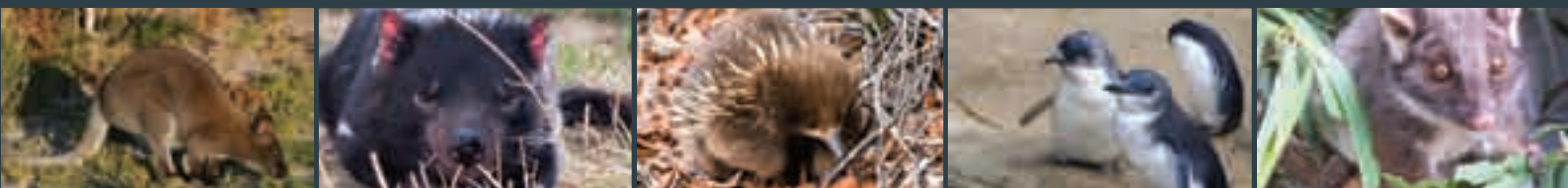
